CANOE ADVENTURE IN ZIMBABWE

CANOE through the World Heritage listed Mana Pools National Park in Zimbabwe and watch on as massive herds of elephant and buffalo hover at the water's edge to drink.

Travel Associates is offering a four day canoe and walking trail adventure through Mana Pools National Park on the southern bank of the Lower Zambezi.

The canoe trail traverses the entire length of the beautiful Mana Pools National Park, which is saturated in bird and animal life with elephants, elands, buffalos, impalas, waterbucks, baboons, monkeys, zebra, warthog and hippos some of the larger herbivores to be seen regularly on the river terraces. Canoeing is at a leisurely pace with plenty of time for game viewing and bird watching.

The walking trails allow guests to enjoy the thrill of seeing big game such as elephant, lion and buffalo on foot.

Prices start from \$1,425* per person twin share and include three nights accommodation in fully serviced camps with bedding, hot showers and meals with waiter service.

Package is available from 15 June to 15 November 2010. International airfares and transfers to/from Mana Pools are not included.
